ARTICULATION TRANSFER AGREEMENT

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Article I Agreement on Principle

Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD) and Washtenaw Community College (WCC) agree that students, who choose to transfer from a community college to a senior college or university to earn a bachelor's degree, should be provided with a smooth curriculum transition that minimizes loss of credit and duplication of coursework. Therefore, Savannah College of Art and Design and Washtenaw Community College agree to create this curriculum articulation agreement for students who complete the Associate in Arts Degree Liberal Arts Transfer at WCC and transfer to SCAD to complete the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography. Both parties enter into this agreement as cooperating, equal partners who shall maintain the integrity of their separate programs.

Article II Agreement on Program Specifics

Savannah College of Art and Design and Washtenaw Community College agree that any student who has successfully completed the minimum requirements outlined on the attached articulation guide may transfer the course credits indicated toward a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography at Savannah College of Art and Design. Students who follow this articulated program agreement must apply and be admitted to Savannah College of Art and Design. WCC students will receive equal consideration with other students seeking admission and financial aid.

Article III Agreement on Communication

Savannah College of Art and Design and Washtenaw Community College agree to cooperate in communicating with each other and with their common and respective publics concerning the established relationship between the two institutions. Faculty and staff at both institutions will share the information in this agreement with interested and qualified students and both institutions will provide counseling and advising to students and prospective students.

Article IV Maintenance and Review Procedures

At least one administrative or faculty member from each institution will be appointed to act as agents for the implementation of this agreement, to speak for the institutions and to communicate changes to respective faculty members, advisors, counselors, and others to whom the information is pertinent. Both parties agree to communicate annually any changes in their respective programs that may affect this articulation agreement.

The courses listed with SCAD equivalencies are currently transferable under the 2012 SCAD course catalog for specific SCAD requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography. Students are subject to the requirements of the SCAD course catalog in effect at the time of his or her entry and registration at SCAD. Students may choose to fulfill requirements of any subsequent SCAD course catalog within five years of their first enrollment at SCAD. This document is specific to Washtenaw Community College's Associate in Arts Degree Liberal Arts Transfer and the Savannah College of Art and Design's Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography. In order for a class to be considered for transfer, it needs to be at least three semester credit hours or five quarter hours. A grade of "C" or higher must be earned in the class. A course transferred from Washtenaw Community College may fulfill only one SCAD course requirement. A maximum of 18 courses may transfer into the SCAD BFA program of study. In some instances, a student's course selection may fulfill a different requirement than listed above. In those specific instances, it may be advantageous in the student's course of study to allow the course to fulfill a different requirement requirement rather than a general education or free elective.

*Courses are subject to portfolio review at SCAD to transfer. Students not passing portfolio reviews may be required to complete more than 90 quarter hours at SCAD.
