



Title: Architectural Collage

Description: Create a collage of text, textures, and images influenced by an architectural form

Procedure:

- Begin by researching modern architecture. Consider looking through textbooks, the internet and magazines such as Architectural Digest or Progress Architecture.
- Find a reference that will serve you well- that is, you will stylize the details of the reference into a somewhat abstract representation. This can be done once the reference is digital, scanned if needed, and opened in Photoshop. Enlarge the image to 11" x 17". Not to worry about the resolution.
- Have a phaser print made.
- Cut simple shapes of the architectural form to serve as a stencil or template for your collage.
- Gather visual references of text and images.
- Cut the samples of text, textures and other images in the various shapes of the abstracted architectural form.
- Assemble and glue the collage sections to take on the original architecture onto foamcore or hot press illustration board/ matboard.
- Photograph the collage and print out on the Epson large-format printer for the course portfolio.
