



Title: Expanded Image Relief

Description: Create a relief of an expanded image of an architectural exterior or interior scene

Procedure:

- Photograph numerous threaded captures of an architectural scene, either an exterior or interior view point. The idea is to place yourself in a stationary position and move the camera to capture a 180° view.
- Print the files on the lab's color printer.
- Over a light table, splice the photos to create a thread of data to present a sequence of images that connect the various components of the scene.
- Lay out the photo sections on mat board or foamcore board. Add thicknesses of board under some sections to create a relief.
- Glue all sections down to the board for final presentation. Consider cutting around the outer areas to create a shaped piece.
- Photo document the work and print out an Epson print of your project for your course portfolio
