Assignment 3 - Photo Restoration and Retouching

Restoring an old photo is a means of restoring memory as well. It is also an art form unto itself. With Photoshop we can rebuild an image to its original glorious color, remove the evidence of an old relationship or repair an image damaged almost beyond recognition.

Find an old photo that needs mending. Scan it, repair it and make a quality ink jet print. We'll use the Epson Scanner, the Clone Stamp , Healing Brush, Spot Healing Brush, the Patch Tool and other tools to make repairs. We'll use the Layers Palette, Selections, Adjustment Layers and Layer Masks tools to restore the picture.

Make a print on an 8.5" x11" sheet of ink jet photo paper. Also, save a copy as a .psd to turn into the "Assignment 3 PSD" Folder and turn in .jpg copies of the original scan and the finished image in the Assignment 3 Folder for critique.
